Age Group:

This program is designed for exceptional individuals with special needs in HFA and AS who are **14-years-old** and above at post-secondary education level.

Admissions:

Students are required to submit a registration form and take placement tests in English (reading and writing) and Mathematics (concepts and calculation) or other placement tests for classes' prerequisite requirements.*

Class Size:

Each class is taught within a group of **4 - 6 students.****

Class Description:

Functional English (Life Skills focus):

Reach an elementary level of speaking, reading and writing using a variety of everyday conversation topics. This will be at the level sufficient to understand letters, newspaper and magazine articles, and be able to compose simple essays.

Functional Math (Life Skills focus):

Everyday uses of math skills will be emphasized. This will include time management, money management and measurement of everyday objects. It is expected that students will use these skills for shopping independently, be able to create a budget, and plan a schedule. This will also serve as preparation for future higher-level math classes.

Communication Skills:

In an interactive class, students learn greeting skills, conversational skills, and nonverbal communication. Students will learn how to be comfortable in a variety of environments and situations.

Computer Application (Word, Excel, Powerpoint):

Learn and master the basic functions of Word, Excel, and Powerpoint. In the summer program, the class' focus is on learning Microsoft Word.

Drama:

Acting on stage. Performing in public. Memorizing scripts. Students will perform in the community for various events.

Exercise and Sports Games

Emphasizing teamwork and fair play, students will build up healthy habits through sports and games. The class is designed for students to learn and love exercise and physical activities, while using problem-solving, logical thinking and adaptation to unexpected situations skills.

Crafts & Stage Decoration:

Students learn how to make various attractive artworks. Students will also make props for Drama class in this program. Through individual projects students are expected to get a great sense of accomplishment. (**Material fee is charged separately from the tuition.**)

Note:

* Students who are interested in taking Computer Application class, will need to take additional tests for typing skill and online search skills.

** *Drama* and *Exercise and Sports Games* may need a larger group of students to attend for certain activities; in such case, there will be instructor's assistants to provide supervision when needed.
