Camp Pioneer Pals is geared towards children ages 3-10 with a diagnosis of autism or social communication delays and their siblings. Children will practice social communication skills in the context of developmentally appropriate, socially engaging, and fun activities. We welcome siblings (one per camper) to join us in creating an inclusive community for our campers and to learn new ways to interact and play with their brother/sister.



Supervised by certified speech language pathologists, campers will engage with siblings and peers to learn skills that promote friendships and social interactions.
