I've asked her to speak about the Draft "Statewide Strategic Framework for Expanding Housing Opportunities for People with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities". I sent a link for it to everyone and we have the opportunity to make comments on it until January 31. We can ask her how this document will have an impact on housing for our families.

GGRC—the agency that serves most of our children—has a new Strategic Plan for 2018-2021. One of their values is "person-centered thinking". This reflects a shift from professional-focus to person-focus. At a future meeting, I would also like to review their plan in respect to our focus on the futures of our children. We can also look at what it means to be on a waiting list for housing, and what kinds of supported living services are provided and by whom.
